REPORTING THE SPECIFIC STYLE IS IMPORTANT BECAUSE IF THE RACE NUMBERS

ALLOWED, WE WILL ALSO DIVIDE THE RACE ACCORDING TO THE SPECIFIC STYLE, IN

ORDER TO ENSURE A FAIRER ASSESSMENT (E.G.: THREE OR MORE SAIDS OVER 35 CLASS C

PRESENT, THE ASSESSMENT WILL BE SAIDI OVER 35 C AND NOT GENERALLY FOLK OVER 35

C).

6. CLOTHING SPECIFICATIONS

Clothing is to be considered free as long as it is appropriate, decorous and appropriate to the choreographic theme. Make up is permitted as long as it is appropriate to the image and age of the dancer.

7. NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS AND CHOREOGRAPHIES ALLOWED

Each team can present an unlimited number of participants and groups, as long as there is no one in each of them who are part of other groups of the same specialty and category.

The dancers must always be ready, according to the schedule, for the call to the floor, under penalty of disqualification from competition.

The number of choreographies to be presented is free as is participation in multiple specialties. The Judging system is based on scores issued by the judges.

1. EVALUATION SYSTEM

The evaluation system includes the following parameters:

- EXECUTION TECHNIQUE
- CHOREOGRAPHY
- MUSICALITY
- SCENE PRESENCE (which includes expressiveness, feeling, bearing)
- -RELEVANCE TO STYLE (valid for oriental, folklore, popular dances and historical dances)
- -SYNCRONY (valid only for duo, trio, small group and group formations)

2. METHOD OF CONDUCT

The competition takes place in rounds; the order of the call is decided by the class of membership in this order: D-C-B-A-M-U.

3. SCORE

From 1 to 10 (1 minimum score, 10 maximum score).

In the event of a TIE, the victory will be awarded to the dancer who obtained the highest technical judgment,

4. MUSIC RULES

The music (in mp3 format) must be sent via email to

meyameyaraqsfestival@gmail.com by renaming the music tracks as below:

solo/duo name or group + specialty + specific style + class. (Ex. Maria Rossi – Folk – Saidi - class B)

Furthermore, in order to safeguard the correct conduct of the competition, it is necessary that the instructor

trainer brings on the day of the competition a USB drive pen with the music tracks of dancers.

5. PENALTIES

Disqualification is foreseen in case of:

- Incorrect behavior of the dancer or a team
- 5 minute delay in arriving at the track
- In case of incorrect specialty compared to the one for which you are registered (e.g. an Oriental in Folk)

6. POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE RACE OFFICIALS

The management staff, the competition judges, the head of the judges and the jury presidents are required to observe the following rules:

- They must be objective, correct and impartial
- They must observe dignified behavior within their role and towards the athletes

- They must always maintain a conduct aligned with the importance of the role of match official The Match officials are responsible for maintaining order in the competition area
- They cannot leave the competition area unless previously agreed with the person in charge judges
- Competition judges, judges in charge and jury presidents must concentrate their attention exclusively on the race. Every action of the participants in the competition must be observed and evaluated carefully. During the event the race officials will not be able to make statements inherent to their work and will only be able to interact with other race officials
- The competition judges must not belong to the sports clubs of the competitors currently competing, therefore there will be a rotation of judges.
